



## Rain Scoring Format

### 2 short sets with a 10-point Match Tiebreak in Lieu of 3<sup>rd</sup> set

#### Sets

- First to win 4 games wins the set
- Ad Scoring
- If score is 3-3, play 5-Point Set Tiebreak
- Possible score outcomes: 4-0, 4-1, 4-2, 4-3

#### 5-Point Set Tiebreak

- First to win 5 points wins the Tiebreak
- Serving rotation for singles (If A vs B): AA, BB, AA, BB
- Serving rotation for doubles (If A/B vs C/D): BB, DD, AA, CC
- Change ends only once after 4 points
- If score is 4-4, "next point wins"
- If score is 4-4, both players/teams come to net, then spin racquet to determine who serves/receives the point; receivers can choose which court to return from
- Coman Tie Break Procedure NOT used
- Possible score outcomes: 5-0, 5-1, 5-2, 5-3, 5-4

#### 10-Point Match Tiebreak

- First to 10 points, win by two points
- Standard tiebreak serving rotation
- Coman Tiebreak Procedure used

### Alternative Scoring at Championships

Use chart below for converting each Fast4 set. If you split sets, use 1-0 as the 3rd set.

Fast4 Set Score in TennisLink

4-3 = 6-4

4-2 = 6-3

4-1 = 6-2

4-0 = 6-0

Example: A score of 4-1, 4-3 would be entered as 6-2, 6-4. A score of 4-0, 2-4, 1-0 would be entered as 6-0, 3-6, 1-0.

### Lateness Penalties When Shortened Scoring is in Effect.

0-5:00 minutes late: loss of toss and 1 game

5:01 – 15:00 late: loss of toss and 2 games

15:01 or more minutes late: Default
